CIS Receives Transformational Grants Supporting Regional Schools

CIS of Northwest Michigan received two competitive grants that will accelerate our impact on students in your school! We received a \$275,000 grant from the Michigan Department of Education that is designed to improve literacy and increase the percentage of students who graduate from high school. The impact of this grant on Mancelona students includes:

- Parent engagement activities at Mancelona schools
- Grief support group at Mancelona Elementary School
- Power Book Bags
- Basic needs supplies for students (nutritional items)
- Middle School partnership with Big Brothers Big Sisters for a school-based mentoring program

Additionally, we received a Scaling Grant of over \$400,000 from CIS National, which will bring our integrated student supports model to the Central Lake and Vanderbilt school districts, and deepen our work at East Jordan Elementary School.
